



PRESS RELEASE ON THE BOMB EXPLOSION AT NYANYA MOTOR PARK, ABUJA, ON MONDAY, 14TH APRIL, 2014.

The Nigerian Bar Association received with sadness the heart breaking news of bomb explosion at the Nyanya Motor Park, Abuja which claimed the lives of over 70 Nigerians and wounded over 300 persons. This dastardly act of terrorism, brings to the fore, the increasing high level of insecurity in Nigeria.

The NBA outrightly condemns the attack in the strongest of terms. It is senseless, callous, devilish and animalistic. Nothing, nothing we repeat, can explain this. This is very much unnigerian. We hereby repeat our call on the Federal Government to redouble its efforts in the war against terror and terrorists, as well as their backers, no matter who and where they may be found. This must stop. We also call on the Security Agencies to stop at nothing in ensuring that those behind this are apprehended and promptly brought to justice.
